Battery and Charger Owner's Manual

Thank you for choosing an EBO conversion kit. In order to correctly use, store, and maintain your battery please read this user manual carefully.

Care

- 1. Do not short circuit your battery by directly connecting the positive and negative poles.
- 2. Do not expose the battery to fire or heat sources.
- 3. Do not shake, impact, or crush violently.
- 4. Do not submerge your battery in liquid of any kind.
- 5. Ambient charging temperature should be 32°F 110°F.
- 6. Ambient discharge temperature should be 0°F 110°F.
- 7. Do not leave a fully charged battery connected to a charger.
- 8. Do not disassemble the Li-ion Battery by yourself. Contact a qualified technician.

Storage, Maintenance, and Transportation

- 1. When the battery is being stored for a prolonged period, charge the battery to 50% and charge the battery every two to three months.
- 2. Store the battery in a clean, dry, and ventilated space.
- 3. Store the battery between 32°F 100°F. Room temperature is best.
- 4. Remove your battery from your bike and keep it inside your vehicle during transport to reduce the risk of damage.

Charging

- 1. Plug the charger output into the charge port of the battery and then plug the AC power plug of the charger into the electrical socket.
- 2. When the battery is charging the charger light will turn red. When the light is green the battery is fully charged or not charging.
- 3. Only use the supplied charger. Do not cover the charger while in use.
- 4. If the battery becomes extremely hot, emits an odor, or becomes deformed discontinue use and take it to a qualified service technician.
- 5. Disconnect a fully charged battery from the charger.
- 6. Do not stick your key in the charge port. Make sure to unplug your charger before riding.
